<b>Character:</b>	<b>Character detail.</b>
<b>Ernest Gribble</b>	Aged 64. Headmaster at the school. Wears old fashioned suit with waistcoat. Very austere character.
<b>Winifred Gribble</b>	Aged 59. Ernest's wife. Administrator. Wears a tweed skirt and blouse. Nervous. Devoted to Ernest.
<b>Matron Forthright</b>	Aged 60. Matron. Has a son called Clifford. Wears old school nurse uniform. Strict and Forthright.
<b>Digger Sturdy</b>	Aged 41. Head Gardener. Hunky and sexy. Wears scruffy gardening clothes. Brooding. Flirty.
<b>Father Worthy</b>	Aged 65. English Teacher. Wears a Priest's outfit. Terribly friendly and kind to everyone.
<b>Lord Kieran</b>	Aged 38. Former Pupil. Very wealthy Irish aristocrat. Wears a very smart suit. Charming and suave (except to Giles!)
<b>Giles Slither</b>	Aged 60. Lord Kieran's manservant. Wears a black suit and bowtie. Subservient and smarmy.
<b>Lady Wendy</b>	Aged 40. Former barmaid. Lord Kieran's wife. Wears low cut blouses and short skirts. Loud and bitchy.
<b>Rick O'More</b>	Aged 38. Twin brother of missing girl, Kathryn. An estate agent. Wears a smart suit. Smooth and smarmy.
<b>Siobhan Slink</b>	Aged 38. Former pupil. Married to a 92 year old millionaire. Wears low cut blouse and short skirt. Loud and flirty.

<b>Character:</b>	<b>Character detail.</b>
<b>Reginald Smythe</b>	Aged 60. General Seagrave's solicitor. Also, Ada Smythe's husband. Very quietly spoken. Wears a smart suit.
<b>Ada Smythe</b>	Aged 59. Reginald Smythe's wife. Glamorous and intelligent but a bit short tempered. Wears glamorous clothes.
<b>Evelyn Seagrave</b>	Aged 24. The General's daughter. Very strident and opinionated. Women's libber. Wears down to earth clothes.
<b>Gladys Seagrave</b>	Aged 25. The General's second wife (now widow). Bouncy and charming. Wears short skirts and heels.
<b>Elsie Wright</b>	Aged 45. Gladys Seagrave's mother. Very motherly and fussy. Wears tweed and fake pearls.
<b>Dick Scott</b>	Aged 19. Train Guard. Good looking and confident. Very helpful. Wears guard's uniform. Slight Italian accent.
<b>Constance O'Leary</b>	Aged 60. Sweet little American lady. Sensible clothes. Very conservative.
<b>Charles Brown</b>	Aged 48. Barman on the train. Mary's father. Very upright and proper. Wears a black suit.
<b>Mary Brown</b>	Aged 24. Waitress/Kitchen Hand on the train. Charles' daughter. Very serious and quiet. Wears a traditional waitress uniform.
<b>Albert Squires</b>	Aged 50. Chef on the train. Keeps himself to himself. Wears Chef's whites.
